Marion H. Mayberg

June 25, 1925—September 13, 2009

Marion H. Mayberg of Port Angeles died in Olympic Medical Center of a brain aneurysm at 84. She was born in Leavenworth to Jim and Ruth (Mueller) Evans. She attended Eastern Washington State College and the University of Washington. On Aug. 26, 1947, she married John Peer "Peter" Mayberg in Peshastin. Mrs. Mayberg divided her energies among being a homemaker, travel agent and executive director of Camp Fire Girls. Her memberships included Oldy Goldy Camp Fire Girls, Navy Mothers, Soroptimist, Eastern Star and Quazar, which is another Masonic organization, as well as Study Club and Doll Club. She also was active with First United Methodist Church, Boys & Girls Club and Walk for Life. Marion had been a Soroptimist since 1972 when she joined SI of Port Angeles Noon Club where she served as president in 1977 and 1978. Marion joined Soroptimist Jet Set at its inception in 1981.
